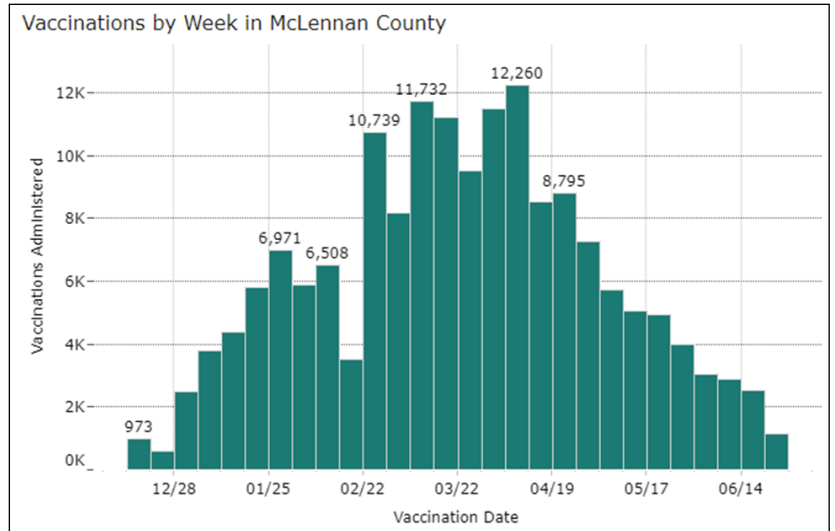

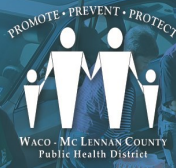
As of June 25, 2021, 53% of the U.S. population, 48% of Texas, and 39% of the McLennan County population that is 12 years and older is fully vaccinated with the COVID-19 vaccine. As of June 20, 2021, the Health District has vaccinated 49,180 individuals. Of those, 70% were 18-64 years of age and 39% were 65 years and older. 17% were Hispanic, 64% were White, Non-Hispanic, and 10% were Black, Non-Hispanic.

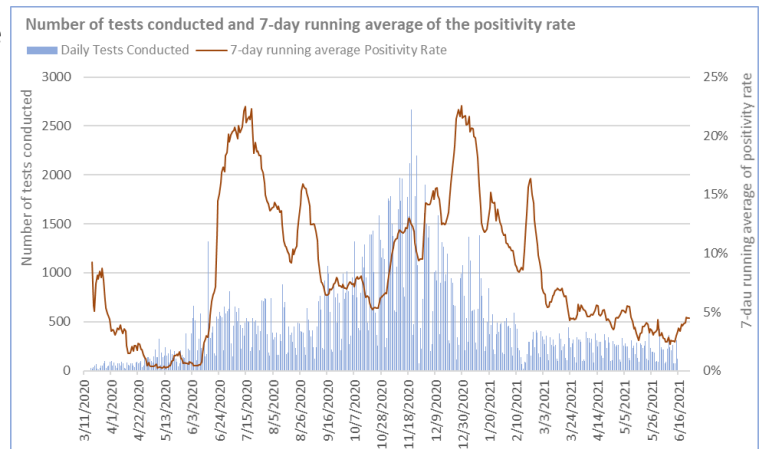

The number of COVID-19 tests that come back positive (percent positivity) continues to decline. The 7-day average of percent positivity from all tests for McLennan County is now 3%.



SARS-CoV-2 VARIANTS

Currently, several variants are found around the world, including in the United States. On June 15, 2021, the B.1.617.2 (Delta)* variant was classified as a Variant of Concern because it spreads from person to person more easily than other variants and may cause more severe disease. B.1.617.2 has been reported in 77 countries and in the United Kingdom has become the main variant in COVID-19 cases. In the United States, the proportion of B.1.617.2 for the 2-week period ending June 19, 2021, is predicted to increase to 20.6% nationally and be higher in regions 2, 6, 7, 8, and 9, which includes Texas.

As of June 22, 2021, 67.5% of the total cases reported in Texas are caused by the B.1.1.7 variant (*Commonly referred as the UK variant*) and 6.5% are caused by the Delta variant. McLennan County currently has reported 29 cases B.1.1.7 and one P.1 variant cases. No cases of the *delta* variant have been identified in McLennan County.
